WEEKLY DEVOTION WITH PASTOR DAVE MINER

Devotion No. 64

Reading: Exodus 34 (Optional Reading: Exodus 33, 35, 36)

"6 And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness," (Exodus 34:6 NIV)

Have you ever wondered who is God really? The God who created and maintains the world. The God who demands that we worship and love him. An all-powerful, all-knowing, all-present person who can do anything, but mostly does not.

People seem to have many ideas about who God is and what he is like. One of the best pictures is found in Exodus 34 where God tells Moses, and each of us, what he is like. And what was that?

Compassionate. God, having been human, fully understands where we hurt, and he feels that hurt with us. He wants only to help us and make us feel safe in the world.

Gracious. God has many gifts, after all, he owns the whole world. His grace means he wants us to give those gifts to all of us. He wants to make eternity in heaven one huge Christmas celebration.

Slow to anger. Often, we think the God of the Old Testament is an angry God – but not really. If the God of Scripture got truly angry with us, where would we be? God is slow to anger. He is always patient, giving us the time and opportunity to change, to come to him through His Son Jesus.

Abounding in loving kindness. God is full of love, in fact, First John 4:16 tells us HE IS LOVE itself,

"God is love." He wants to pour out his love on each of us, every day, all day.

Lord, I praise you that you are the greatest of all, and I trust in you. Amen.


