"³ If you walk in my statutes and observe my commandments and do them, then I will give you your rains in their season, and the land shall yield its increase, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit. (Leviticus 26:3-4 NIV)"

That night, he knelt by his bed and prayed, "God, haven't I been obedient? Where is the blessing?" I said, "Well you have a better relationship with your sister, right? That is a blessing. A good grade on the test is a blessing. Your friend came to church. Could not that have been the blessing?" The student thought about it and decided maybe God's blessings were not gifts and rewards. Blessings were linked to the obedience. He decided to look for his blessings in that way.

Jesus, your blessings are all very good. Thank you. Amen.
