CALLING A SENIOR PASTOR

MESSAGE FROM THE CONGREGATON PRESIDENT Randy Mayer

"Few actions of a congregation impact its future direction and viability more extensively than the calling of a pastor."

The time has come for our congregation to issue a call to a senior pastor. There are three candidates resulting from the committed work of our call committee and support of the Southeastern District, LCMS. Your role on May 7 will be critical in the life of our congregation. Here is what to expect.

CALL SERVICE ITINERARY

- Call service opens with prayer and scripture readings as we seek guidance from the Holy Spirit in selecting a pastor.
- Call service transitions to a special voters meeting where the call committee presents a brief background on three candidates. Voting commences until one of the candidates wins a clear majority. (The pastor will be contacted after the service by church leaders to formally extend the call.)
- Return to the call service to conclude with prayers and hymns of hope and thanksgiving.

Reading: Deuteronomy 21

(Optional Reading: Deuteronomy 22 - 24)

"20 They shall say to the elders, "This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious. He will not obey us. He is a glutton and a drunkard." (Deuteronomy 21:20 NIV)

Disobedience is serious in the eyes of God. The Bible talks of ways parents can keep their children in line. Parents are never to abuse their little ones, but they are to discipline them when they do things wrong.


Sometimes young people start doing far worse things than coming home late or telling a little lie. Sometimes they get into drugs, drinking, sex, and other things that can lead to their destruction. I understand now when my dad would lecture me, "Nothing good happens after midnight." When parents today must give up on a child because of their sin, they usually let them go off on their own and suffer the consequences of their immoral behavior.

In the Old Testament, though, disobedience invited a much worse fate than that. A young man or woman could be executed because of his or her sin. It was that serious.

We do not resort to such measures today. God tells us to show mercy and compassion, even to unbelievably bad people. No matter your age, disobedience is a serious matter in the eyes of God. Look closely at your life. Are you disobeying your parents about a situation or problem? If you are older, are you sinning against someone ... or God? Stop! Confess it to God and make it right with your parents or against whomever you are sinning. Then your life will be blessed and preserved.

Father, help me to learn to obey You when I do not feel like it. Amen.


