Once this evaluation has been completed and the document is updated, as required, it should be ready for submission to the District.

An additional part of the call process is requesting **nominations** from the congregation of potential candidates for our call. **Forms are located in the Narthex and need to be submitted no later than October 2, 2022.**

Devotion No. 58**

Reading: Exodus 5 (Optional Reading: Exodus 6-8)

"22 Moses returned to the LORD and said, "Why, Lord, why have you brought trouble on this people? Is this why you sent me?" (Exodus 5:22 NIV)

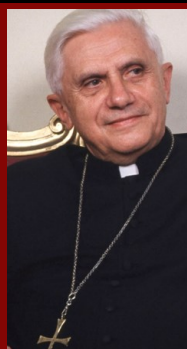
Trouble happens to everyone. Maybe not today, or tomorrow, but eventually, trouble will invade your life—at school, church, your family, your friends. No matter who you are trouble finds us all. God commanded Moses to barter with Pharaoh (the king of Egypt) and lead the people out of slavery. Moses, after trying to get out of the whole thing, went along with God. When Moses appeared before Pharaoh, things got worse. Pharaoh told Moses to get out of his palace and then ordered the Jews to make bricks without straw. This was a problem; without straw, the bricks were much harder to make.

Moses' troubles got worse! When he got back to the Jewish leaders, they screamed at him. How could he do this to them? What was he thinking? Moses ran into his tent and complained to God. "How could you do this to me?" he cried.

In the end, God showed Moses he was completely in charge. He made it possible for the Jews to escape from Egypt, but only after more trouble occurred. Having troubles is not always a terrible thing. God sometimes allows them for one reason: so, we will run to Him and ask for help. Do you have trouble today? You need to go to God and get divine help!

Heavenly Father, let me never forget that you are there to help me. Amen.

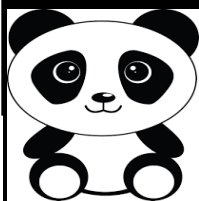
SUNDAY FELLOWSHIP

Please use the Sign-Up Sheet on the Kitchen door to help us plan, and please indicate if you can also make coffee.

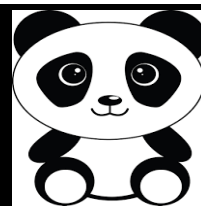

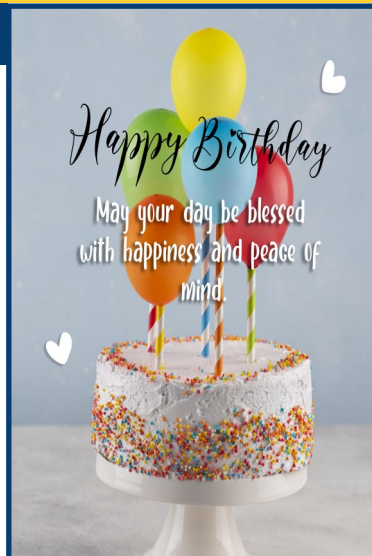
