Reading: Exodus 9 (Optional Reading: Exodus 10, 11)

"10 So they took soot from a furnace and stood before Pharaoh. Moses tossed it into the air, and festering boils broke out on people and animals." (Exodus 9:10 NIV)

Imagine one morning you wake up, and your bed is covered with frogs! You run to the shower to wash yourself off, and blood comes out of the faucet. Just days later, flies infest your home, so many you can hardly breathe without sucking a couple down your throat. Days later, your animals all die. And one day, a darkness that you can feel comes on the land. You cannot see a thing, even your hand in front of you. Finally, days later, your father, who is the first son of your grandparents, and your older brother are sick with a horrible disease. That night both your father and older brother die.

Pretty miserable situation. It would be hard to imagine. Yet, that is exactly what God did to the Egyptians when they would not let the Jewish people go free. God sent 10 plagues in all. The last one involved the death of every firstborn son and animal.

God did this to Egypt to show his power. He wanted the world to know that he ruled in heaven and earth, and no one could resist him.

Do you see God as a great God of power? He is. He can do more than we would ever ask or think. So why not ask today?

Father, I praise you that you are all-powerful. I trust you to strengthen me. Amen.


