Praying Our Way Forward (Matthew 7:7-12 NIV)

Have you heard the story about the pastor and the taxicab driver who happened to die at the same time? They arrived simultaneously at the Pearly Gates. The taxicab driver went to a fabulous palace, complete with fountains, a slide for the pool, and an army of servants. Meanwhile, the pastor was ushered down a lonely lane to an extremely modest place where he was invited to spend eternity. Discerning the discrepancy between the two rewards, the pastor complains to St. Peter saying, "Look, I spent my entire life ministering to other people. If the taxicab driver deserves a mansion, why don't I get one, too?" St. Peter immediately responded by saying, "Well, up here, we go strictly by results. When you preached, people slept. When the taxicab driver drove, people prayed."

As we enter the Advent and Christmas seasons, I ask you to join me in prayer. I ask you to pray daily for this church of ours that we love. Let us not talk about prayer, read about prayer, or even right now, study about prayer. Let each of us pray. Let every move we make, every decision we take, be an action directed by God's will. I suggest the following three statements as a guide for our prayer time together in the days to come.

"Ask and it will be given to you." Jesus said in the Sermon on the Mount, "Ask and it will be given to you;" Let your requests be known to God. The writer of James 4:2b says, "You do not have because you do not ask God." I do not know why God, in his divine providence, wants his children to express their needs, but it is all through the Bible and we best embrace it wherever we find it. Jesus reasons, "if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? ... how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!" God is not a Santa Claus with a need to fulfill a gigantic wish list. God is like a heavenly parent who wants to be engaged with his children. I ask you to ask.

"Seek and you will find." To seek is to hunt, to pursue, to delve into, to explore, to try to discover. God and God alone should guide our decisions, I ask as your pastor and friend to take a long look and listen before you leap. What dreams can you still fulfill for the glory of God? What more could you do for the good of others? Is there a role you can take for the kingdom of God in this place? How do we proceed in our search for our next pastor, DCE, organist. Seek and you will find. I have watched people seek before and I can guarantee they find.

"Knock and the door will be opened for you." The doors of opportunity will open for you. The angel says to the church in Philadelphia in Revelation 3, "Behold, I set before you an open door which no one can shut." The angel might have written that about Redeemer Lutheran Church. Our potential has never been greater. Through the last few years have raised challenges, God has things for us to do, and dreams for us to fulfill. It is time to step through the door of opportunity. The prayer of Jabez, a minor character in the Old Testament, in Chronicles 4:9 says, "Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge my territory!" I ask you during the Advent and Christmas seasons to pray with me that we hear and resolve to act on the whole will of God, now and forever. Amen.

Confirmation for Adults - Need a Refresh?

Confirmation is one part of a life-long sharing of God's gifts. Confirmation helps you organize all the stuff you have learned over the years and fill in blank spots you may have ... or may have forgotten.

- Confirmation prepares you to make your own public profession of Christian faith first made at your baptism by parents and sponsors.
- Confirmation helps you understand how you fit in the church and how you are part of the marvelous Body of Christ.
- Confirmation explores God's great love for the world, and for you, explaining it in a meaningful way.
- Most importantly, Confirmation provides a fundamental understanding of Christian Faith so that we can attend Holy Communion and receive its full benefits.

Over the course of the program, we will explore the six chief parts of Luther's Small Catechism, the Ten Commandments, the Lord's Prayer, the Apostles' Creed, Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confession and Absolution, as well as other key themes of Christian life.

Proposal: In 2024, Pastor Dave is exploring how to offer a confirmation refresh for adults, or those adults who have not, but would like to take a confirmation course. If you are interested, signup in the Lobby/Narthex so that we may better appreciate the need within Redeemer.







